Isaiah 55:10-11 says, "For as the rain comes down, and the snow from heaven, and returns not thither, but waters the earth, and makes it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater: so shall my word be that goes forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it." God's work and blessings

God is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him (Heb 11:6). Our foundation

Satan's first point of attack against Eve was to shake her faith in the word of God. Before her encounter with the serpent, Eve's faith was one hundred percent in what she had heard from God (Rom 10:17). Concerning the fruit of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil in the midst of the garden, she confidently affirmed: "God hath said. Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die" (Gen 3:3). In reply, the serpent said to her, "Ye shall not surely die" (Gen 3:4). As soon as she doubted God's word, she was successfully deceived and committed the first sin (Gen 3:5-6). We should not be ignorant of this device of the devil (2 Cor 2:11), as he is trying to attack our faith in God's word too. Men like Jeroboam have attempted to physically destroy the documents upon which God's word has been written (Jer 36:20-26). But God does not let such attempts succeed in destroying our ability to know what He has said (Jer 36:27-32). Therefore, God has preserved completely accurate copies of the original documents upon which was written the words that He inspired through the prophets and apostles. He has also blessed mankind with trustworthy translations of His word into the various languages that people speak. God makes a promise in Matthew 7:7-8: "Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: for every one that asks receives; and he that seeks finds; and to him that knocks it shall be opened." We can find our Creator's will because it is preserved in our Bibles. As our Lord said in Matthew 4:4, we truly can live by every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God!
